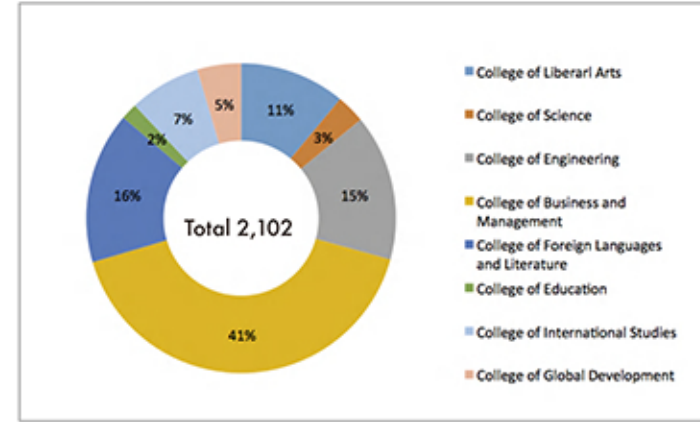

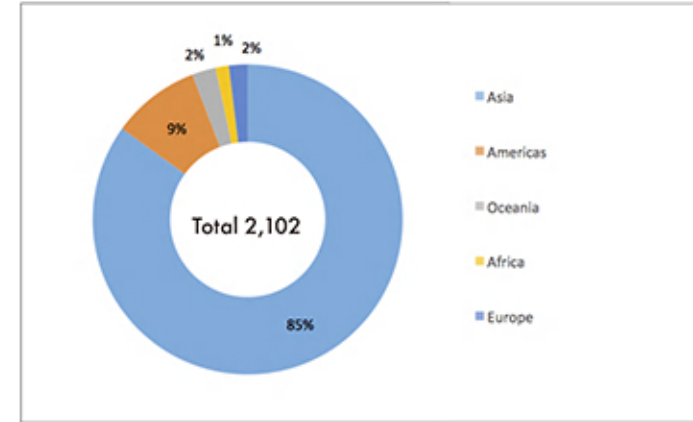
Overseas Degree Students

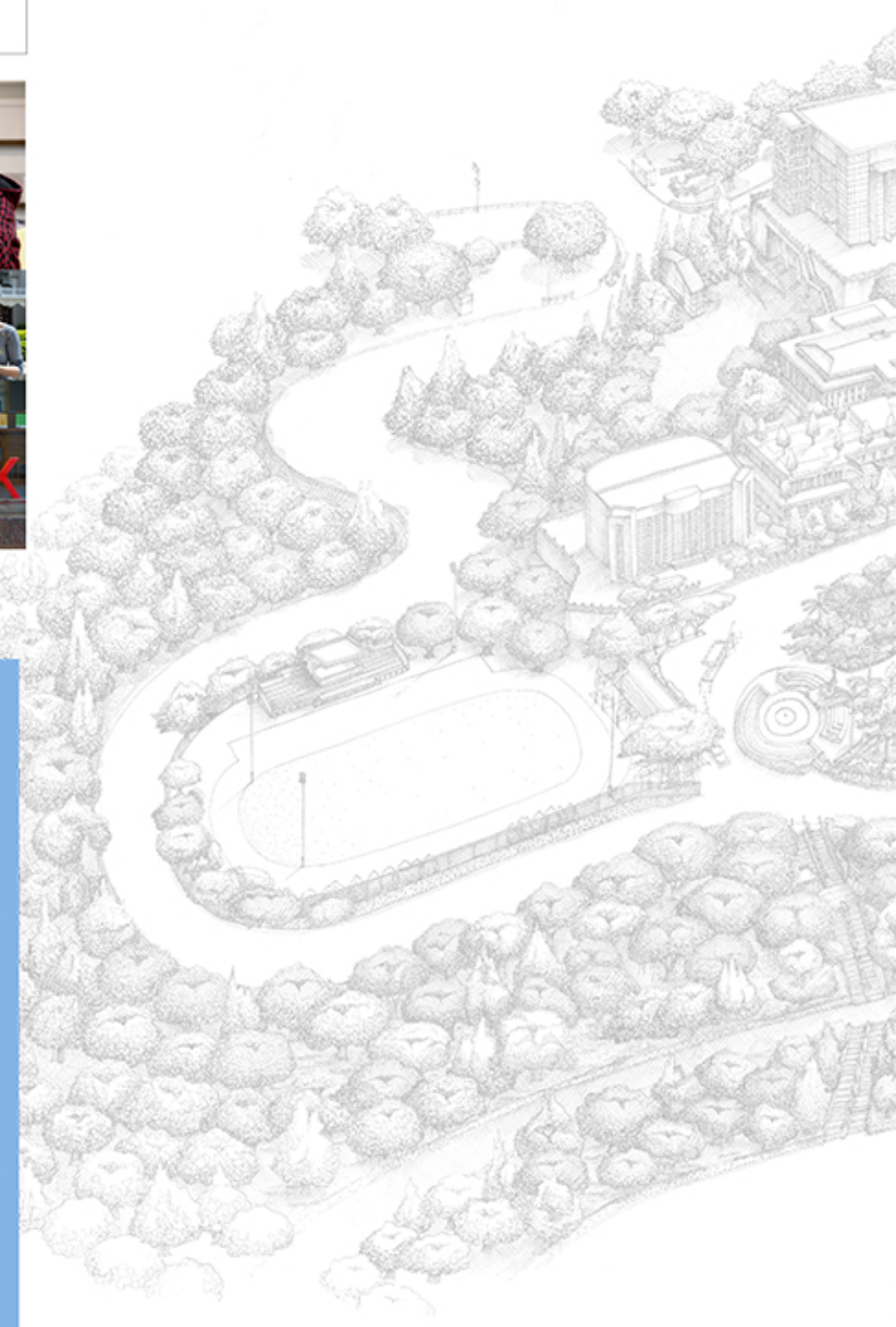

Founded in 1950 as the Tamkang Junior College of English by Mr. Chang Ching-sheng and his son Dr. Clement C. P. Chang, Tamkang was the first private college in Taiwan. It became the Tamkang College of Arts and Sciences in 1958, before being renamed as Tamkang University in 1980. Tamkang University has been emphasizing "Triple Objectives": Globalization, Information-oriented Education, and Future-oriented Education.

Tamkang provides a holistic educational environment and aims at equipping students with eight qualities: a global perspective, information literacy, a vision for the future, moral integrity, independent thinking, a cheerful attitude and healthy lifestyle, a spirit of teamwork and dedication, and a sense of aesthetic appreciation.
