TKU Guidelines for Implementing Exemption from English (I) and English (II) for Bachelor Students

Secretariat Regulation No. 1010000077 (10/26/2013)

- 1. In order to help TKU students with excellent English ability acquire an exemption from the courses of English (I) and English (II) and fully utilize the educational resources, these guidelines have been enacted.
- 2. The application for exemption from English (I) and English (II) must be transacted once the first semester of each academic year; those whose application is approved are exempted from the courses.
- 3. Foreign students and overseas Chinese students whose mother tongue is English can apply for the exemption from the English department. The application form can be downloaded from the English department's website and should be sent to the English department for inspection.
- 4. If students conform with the above-mentioned article 3, they should check the related documentation within the second week of the first semester of each academic year and according to regulations submit the application for exemption to the English department.
- 5. Those whose exemption from English (I) and English (II) has been approved must themselves select courses totaling 8 credits to make up for the total number of credits required for graduation

Six credits of the aforementioned self-selected 8 credits must come from the General Education curriculum of the student's Collegial Core curriculum and 2 credits from Foreign Languages and Drills. Students cannot take foreign language classes of their mother tongue.

6. This set of guidelines will take effect on the date of its publication after being passed in an academic affairs meeting and approved by the TKU President. The same applies to any later amendments made.
