

TKU Guidelines for Exemption from Foreign Language Classes for the Lanyang Campus

Secretariat Regulation No. 1030000040 (28/07/2014)

1. The Guidelines for Exemption from Foreign Language Classes for the Lanyang Campus (hereinafter referred to as the guidelines) are formulated for students excellent in the English that they can be exempt from language courses (English Reading, English Writing, Oral Communication in English and English Proficiency Test).
2. The application of exemption from the courses (English Reading, English Writing, Oral Communication in English and English Proficiency Test) is made once the first semester of each academic year; those whose application is approved are exempt from taking the courses.
3. Foreign and overseas Chinese students whose mother tongue is English are entitled to apply to the Department of English Language and Culture in the second week of the first semester of each academic year; they should provide the related certificate of proof and the application form (download at the website of the department) for review by the department.
4. If the exemption is approved (from taking English Reading, English Writing, Oral Communication in English and English Proficiency Test), applicants must by themselves select courses totaling eight credits in order to meet the criterion for graduation.

The made-up eight credits of the preceding paragraph should involve Artistic Appreciation and Creation Program of the Features Core Curriculum (2 credits), Civilization and Participation Program/Philosophy and Religion Program of the College Core Curriculum (4 credits) and any two 2-credit courses of any corresponding department.

5. These guidelines will take effect on the date of their publication after being passed in an academic affairs meeting and approved by the TKU President. The same applies to any later amendments made.
