Serves as a research project coordinator, and receives external research projects submitted to and recorded by the TKU Office of Research and Development for reference (not including NSTC special research projects or MOE USR projects), and pays administration fees in each year. Two points awarded for each case in each year; One extra point added for every 300,000 TWD up to four points at most. (twenty points at most)</li> <li>2. Publishes a paper in an academic journal or specialized book, and receives a TKU research award within the duration of his or her employment contract. Two points awarded for each article or book. If the paper is published in a NSTC journal that is first or second in its academic field, each such article paper will earn the teacher one extra mark. The same article cannot earn extra marks more than once.</li> <li>3. Receives a local patent (two points for each such case) or an international patent (four points each).</li> <li>4. Presents an artistic work or holds an artistic exhibition, either at TKU or elsewhere. Two points awarded for each solo exhibition; one point for</li> </ol>
